

Main Rules of GTT – “ PRO”

PRO PLAYERS TOUR (for all players starting from 12 and Under willing to get a WC in International Events organised under GTF)

The purpose of the tour is to give opportunity to the players who are competing in Tennis Europe Under 12 and higher level of events, of getting WC for the international tournaments held in Georgia.

The Georgian Tennis Federation will organize the week before the beginning of the TE or ITF sanctioned tournament a WC event with the formula of knock out draw regardless the number of participants. Matches will be played at best of 2 tie break sets with no ad and Match tiebreak 10 points at 1 set all.

These tournaments will allow 50 percent of MD WC and 2 Q WC.

The tournaments will allow the players of getting of 50% of the points awarded in Georgian Championships.

Finalists: 2 MD – WC – Will play for the title and Ranking points. (Tournaments are counting in the 50% + 1 Mandatory to be played every year)

Semi Finalists: 2 Q WC

Remaining Wild Cards will be distributed as follow:

GTF: 1 MD Wild Card + 50% of the remaining Q Wildcards (according to the Circuit Regulations)

Organisers: 1 MD Wild card + 50% of the remaining Q Wildcards (according to the Circuit Regulation)

The Points gained during these events, will be added to the national ranking system and will be valid for 1 year. The ranking will be based on the sum of all the points gained in every tournament played.

The national ranking will be used for seeding in the Georgian Championships.

Exceptions are granted only to the players who are part of the Davis Cup and BJK Cup and willing to participate to the Georgian Championships. They will be considered as Direct Acceptances for the Georgian Championships but they are not eligible to get WC in the international Events held in Georgia unless receiving one of the free WC from Organisers or GTF.

Rules above can be amended during the year.

Entry process for the tournaments – Draws -

- The entry for every tournament organized at the national level is on Thursday at 12.00 noon Tbilisi Time.
- Draws will be automatically generated by GTF Officiating Department and published the same day on the Portal.
- Order of play will be prepared by the Referee of the event
- Allocation of seeds or position in the groups/draws, will be decided by GTF Officiating according to the latest Ranking available. (Only for the first months of 2022 will be used the previous year ranking)
- All the matches will be played based on these rules and on the Tennis Rules of ITF unless differently stated in the National Circuit Rules.
